### Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2 (NSP2) Funding Application

Five housing authorities in Mississippi, including Biloxi Housing Authority, Bay Waveland Housing Authority, Hattiesburg Housing Authority, Laurel Housing Authority, and McComb Housing Authority, have formed a consortium to apply for Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2 funding.

The consortium, led by the Biloxi Housing Authority, is requesting \$48,038,118 in Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2 funds to acquire and redevelop blighted, abandoned, vacant and foreclosed properties.

The intent of the program is for each of the organizations to construct new affordable housing units to replace the blighted and obsolete housing units in the census tracts listed below. NSP2 funding will also be used to fund related soft costs in the development of the new housing.
